

REFLEX EXAM

LOWER EXTREMITY REFLEXES

The patient sits on the edge of the table, dangling her feet while Dr. Leonard checks her reflexes. If the doctor stands too close, he may get kicked.



UPPER EXTREMITY REFLEX

Dr. Leonard does reflex examination of the biceps, triceps, brachial radialis, and wrist and finger flexors as part in most initial examinations. Abnormal reflexes are signs that may suggest neuropathy, stroke, herniated disks, or other neurological diseases.
